

Financial Stability Reports

Over the last two decades, central banks around the globe have been moving towards greater communication and transparency in sharp contrast to the conventional wisdom that central banks say as little as possible. One approach to such greater communication that is being used is an increasing number of Financial Stability Reports (FSRs). The FSRs, released by Reserve Bank of India, are periodic exercise for reviewing the nature, magnitude and implications of risks that may have a bearing on the macroeconomic environment, financial institutions, markets and infrastructure. These reports will also assess the resilience of the financial sector through stress tests. The Department of Economic Affairs also contributes to these reports.
